

## The Line-O Map

The Line-O Map is drawn on a scale of 1:10,000. The grid lines on the map are drawn to Grid North, hence adjustment for magnetic declination is necessary to obtain a magnetic bearing.

Instead of the control circles there are a series of inter-connecting lines indicating the “course” to be followed.

There are 6 controls to find. These controls may be located anywhere along the lines indicating the “course” or at a “turn point”.

The task is to navigate along the lines indicated on the map as closely as possible using a compass bearing.

There is a start location indicated on the map. This is a control flag WITHOUT a punch. This will assure you that you are on the course, BUT if you are comfortable that you have found the course by using other map features you can start anywhere on the lines and travel clockwise or anticlockwise around the course.

This year, at every change in direction along the course you will find a “TURN” card:



This will be an aid to indicate that you are still “on-course”.
